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Welcome Back Class of 1982!

The 25th Reunion Committee welcomes you back to the United States Naval Academy. Five years ago we last gathered in Annapolis to celebrate our many accomplishments, look back to our days in the Yard, and look ahead to greater successes. We had one heck of a fine party! This year, we will continue that grand tradition. The Reunion Committee has put together a great schedule of events that is sure to make for a memorable weekend. This information will help you navigate through the busy weekend.

REUNION WEEKEND NARRATIVE AND SUGGESTED DRESS CODES:

Thursday, September 19th.

Registration/Check-in: The Reunion begins with check-in at the Visitors Center, just inside of Gate One in the seaward side of Halsey Field House. If you need to register and you have not registered online you **MUST** go to the Visitors Center. Check in is open from 12:00 to 4:00pm. **We will only be able to accept cash for walk in registrations, there is an ATM in Dahlgren Hall.**

Current USNA security has significantly limited vehicular access to the yard. If you do not have a DoD sticker on your car, we recommend that you park at the stadium and take the free cable car style shuttle trolleys to the Academy. Look for the NAVY BLUE line trolley. The trolleys leave the stadium bus kiosks on the hour and will drop you off outside of Gates 1 and 3. If you do not have a DoD ID card you must enter through Gate 1. Parking at the stadium is \$5. There are limited downtown parking options with no shuttle bus access. If you do have a DoD sticker on your car, remember, parking on the yard is very limited. **You *must* have a photo ID if you are 16 years or older to enter the academy.**

The rest of the day is open for personal tours of the yard and shopping at the Midshipmen Store. All are encouraged to tour the yard and see the new and refurbished buildings. Walk up the steps into Bancroft too, and see the newly renovated Memorial Hall and the great work done in Smoke Hall

The Crab Feast will take place at Mike's Crab house at 3030 Old Riva Rd. The crab feast will start at 1900. It is just across the South River Bridge on the left. Parking is very limited, carpool if you can. No walk-ups for this event will be accepted. **Dress:** Dress for all events Thursday is casual/comfortable.

Friday, September 20th.

Check-in: Check-in continues at the Visitor's Center as more classmates arrive.

Shuttles: In addition to the free city shuttles, there will be additional Class of '82 Shuttle buses that will cycle between the stadium and Alumni Hall from 0900-1800 on Friday only.

There will be touring on the yard all day with opportunities to shop at the Mid-Store or the Visitor's Center.

The Golf Outing tees off at 0900 across the river at the Naval Academy Golf Course. It will be a shot gun start and Captain's Choice format. We are sharing the course with '72 and we will probably set up some form of friendly competition.

At 1400 we will hold our Class Memorial Service in honor of our fallen classmates. The service will be held in the Chapel. Joining the class will be a number of loved one's of our classmate's families. It should be a very memorable event. Please join us and honor them.

Also at 1400, there will be an optional Supt's Welcome briefing. The briefing will be held in Mahan Hall. If you plan to attend, please be seated by 1350.

At 1600, the class is invited to watch the Brigade P-Rade on Worden Field. There is a section reserved for us in the bleachers. There are four classes having reunions so it has not been determined where the '82 seats will be assigned, so look for the signs.

Dress: Casual/comfortable clothes and shoes

Shuttle Buses will be staged at Alumni Hall after the P-Rade to take classmates back to the Stadium. The last bus will leave the yard at 1800.

The Friday Evening Reception starts at 1800. The reception is being held in the '53 Pavilion in the north end of the stadium. Enter through the gate near the ticket office where you will see the '82 banner.

In addition to gathering with our classmates to eat, drink and catch up on old memories, the evening is a great opportunity to walk through the stadium and see the various new memorials. For those that have not been in the Stadium since its renovation, you will marvel at the great work done to refurbish Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium. The class of '82 arch is on the opposite end of the stadium.

We will have a photographer at the Reception to take company group photos and we will be showing a short video that was prepared especially for this reunion. We have tried to maximize the ability of classmates to reconnect, talk, tell old stories and tour the stadium.

Vehicles may not be left in the Stadium parking lot over night. They will be towed before the game.

Dress: Dressy Casual, no jeans or shorts.

Saturday, September 9th.

Start the day with a **FUN RUN** with the '82 Cross Country and Track Teams. At 0800, they will meet at Hubbard Hall and take a leisurely jog around the yard.

The Tailgater: The tailgater starts at 1100 in the '53 Pavilion and the adjacent tent. We will be entering through the gate in the Northwest corner of the endzone where the "Class of '82" banner is hung. Please note the parking restriction under "Driving and Parking in Annapolis and Stadium parking" below. Parking will be available at Germantown Elementary, one block away from the stadium. **You must have a ticket to get into the stadium as well as a wrist band for the tailgater.**

The Tailgater is often the highlight of the weekend. A new stadium, a successful Navy team, great food and drink (seven hours worth!), old friends – now we're talking! **GO NAVY! BEAT DUKE!** **Dress:** Appropriate Navy attire – Weather dependent.

Sunday, September 10th. Brunch has been canceled by the USNA Administration so companies and friends are able to get together one last time before folks head for home.

DRIVING AND PARKING IN ANNAPOLIS AND STADIUM PARKING. If you **MUST** drive, remember that traffic in and around Annapolis on Reunion weekends is often busy. Parking spaces are hard to find. Due to security restrictions, no non-Department of Defense stickered vehicles are allowed onto the grounds of the United States Naval Academy. Game day parking at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium is *strictly limited* to those with a pre-paid parking pass. Off-site parking is available at Germantown Elementary located behind the stadium.

NAVAL ACADEMY STORE: Also known as the Mid Store, the Naval Academy Store will be open to Alumni members and Reunion attendees. Please have a valid ID card along with your Reunion name tag and/or your USNA Alumni Association Life Member card. Hours are:

NAME TAGS: Please bring and wear your name tag to all Reunion events.

TAILGATER WRISTBANDS: Maryland State law requires our Tailgate vendor to establish a control system for alcohol service. We will control who is allowed into the tailgate area with color-coded wrist bands that must be worn to get in to the controlled area and obtain food and beverages. Wristbands will be issued at check-in. Don't forget to wear them to the tailgater!

PHOTOGRAPHER INFORMATION: A professional photographer will be taking photographs during the reunion. Informal Photos will be made available via the web following the reunion weekend.

FOOTBALL TICKETS: Football tickets are required to get into the Tailgater. If you do not have your ticket yet, either go online to www.navysports.com or go to the Navy Ticket Office in Ricketts Hall.
