General Visiting Information: Visiting hours are sunrise to sunset or 5 p.m., whichever is later. All visitors 21 years of age or older must have a valid picture ID (i.e.: State issued driver's license, student I.D., or a government issued passport).

.

As of 4 February and Effective Immediately

-- State driver's licenses from **Minnesota**, **Illinois**, **Missouri**, **New Mexico** or **Washington** and identification cards from **American Samoa** are non-compliant with the Real ID Act.

-- Until further notice, individuals presenting credentials from the above states and territory must provide a **second form of identification**, and in many cases **IT MUST INCLUDE A PHOTO** (contrary to initial guidance).

-- Individuals who provide driver's licenses from states that do not meet Real ID Act requirements must provide an additional approved form of ID listed in table <u>12-1 of CNICINST</u> <u>5530.14a, Ashore Protection Program.</u>

Children 21 yrs old or younger: who do not have their own ID card must be accompanied by a responsible adult (Parent, or Family Member) who has a valid REAL ID Compliant ID Card

Effective July 1 2013: the requirement for DOD Decals has been eliminated. Anyone with locally prepared USNA ID Card or a DOD credential, including military retirees and dependents are not required to have a decal or get a temporary pass to drive onto USNA. ALL parents and sponsor parents must present their Parent Pass when entering USNA.

Parent Passes: are issued to parents before or during plebe parent weekend. If a parent pass is lost during the 4 years at USNA, your MID must submit an email to the <u>Pass & ID</u> requesting a new pass for parent. **Questions?** Please email <u>Pass & ID</u> or 410.293.4019

All day parking is available at the Navy-Marine Corps Stadium on Rowe Blvd., in the Noah Hillman Parking Garage (accessible from Duke of Gloucester or Main Streets), or at two-hour parking meters around City Dock.
