LT Garrett Wiedle was born and raised in Spotsylvania, VA. He graduated from the United States Naval Academy in 2019 with a Bachelor of Science in General Engineering.

In 2021 he reported to USS JEFFERSON CITY (SSN 759) in Hawaii, where he served as the Supply Officer and completed a Homeport Change to Guam, two Western Pacific Deployments, two Surge Deployments and multiple missions vital to national security. On mission, he served as primary Contact Manager. After being properly relieved, he volunteered to return to JEFFERSON CITY to support critical forward deployed operations. During his time onboard, the ship earned a Meritorious Unit Commendation, Navy Unit Commendation, Navy Expeditionary Medal, as well as Commander, Submarine Squadron SEVEN's 2021 Battle Efficiency Award, and U.S. Pacific Fleet's 2021 Arleigh Burke Fleet Trophy.



In 2023 he transitioned to serve as the Aviation Support Department (ASD) Officer at Naval Air Station Whidbey Island, WA. Under his leadership, ASD earned three Blue "E" for Supply Excellence Awards for 2023, 2024, and 2025 as well as an overall grade of "Excellent" in their 2024 Supply Management Assessment (SMA) and 2025 Supply Management Inspection (SMI).

He currently serves as the Supply Officer, as well as Legal and Contracting Officer, for the U.S. Naval Flight Demonstration Squadron in Pensacola, FL. Leading a skilled team of sailors and marines, he supports over 160 personnel in their duties executing 64 flight demonstrations across 32 show sites around the United States annually.

LT Wiedle is qualified in Naval Aviation (Supply Officer) and Submarine Warfare (Supply Officer). His personal awards include two Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medals, one Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, and various unit awards.
