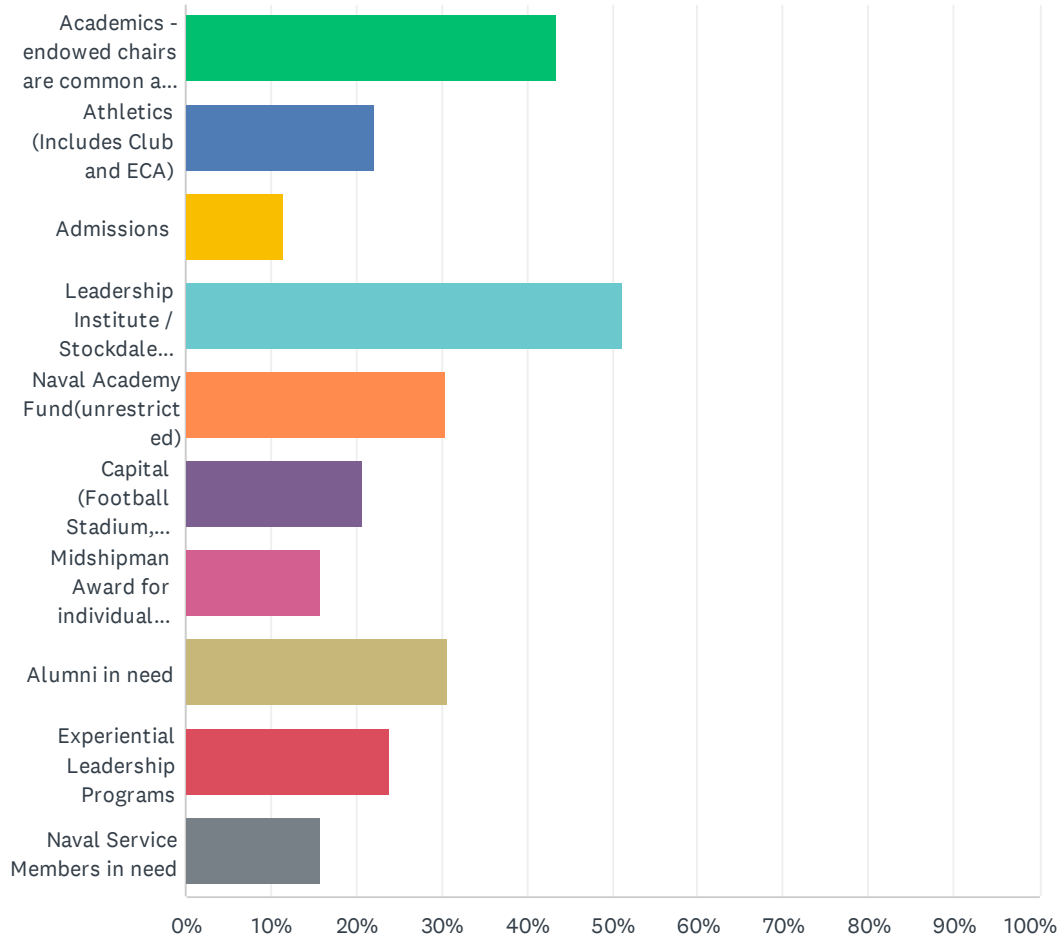


# Q1 Please choose where or to whom you wish your funds to be sent by selecting all that apply.

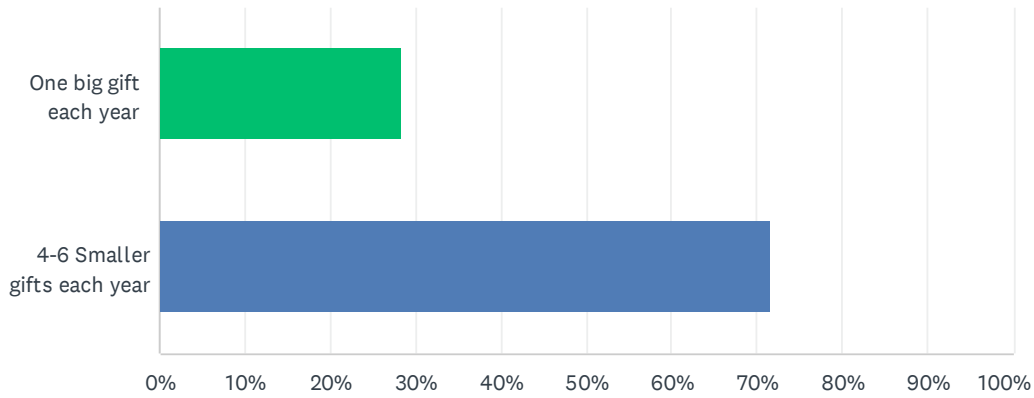

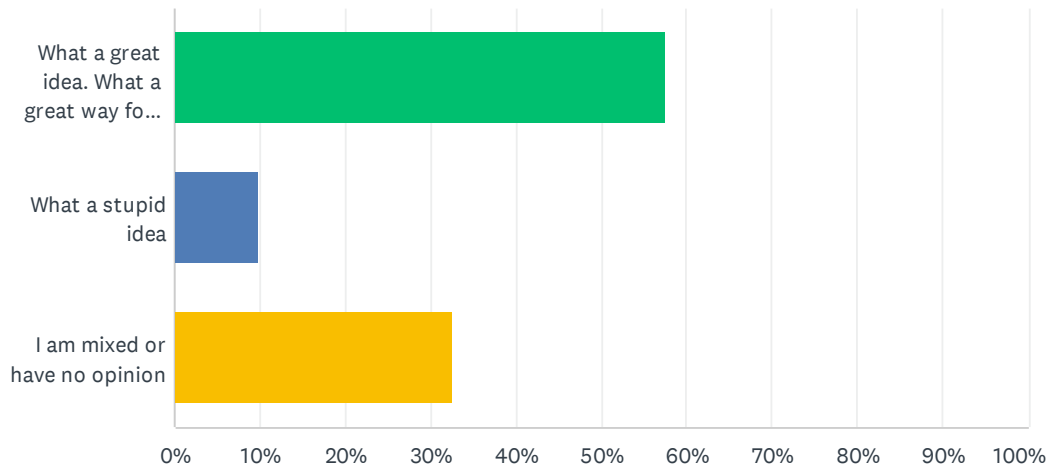
